Emergency Room Discharge Instruction Sheet for Lacerations

Wound Care Instructions

- Keep the area clean and dry at all times.
- Apply a thin layer of Bacitracin, Neosporin or Triple antibiotic ointment to the suture line twice daily.
- If dried blood or crusting occurs between the sutures, apply peroxide to a Q-tip and gently remove.
- You may shower 24 hours after the sutures are placed.
- After showering, pat the area dry. Do not rub.
- Do not use Band-Aids or other bandages unless specifically directed.
- Do not submerge the wound in water for prolonged periods of time. (No swimming or bathing)
- If prescribed, take antibiotics and pain medicines as directed.
- Avoid asprin or asprin containing products for two weeks.
- Avoid all sun exposure to the laceration. Do not use sunblock until the sutures are removed.
- Avoid the use of home remedies: Vitamin E, Cocoa butter, Aloe etc.
- The follow up appointment for suture removal should be scheduled for ______.
